

# Safety Instructions

## RIB Unlimited 36:

**The boat is equipped with:**  
2 x 280 hp inboard Steyr diesel engines, GPS, chartplotter, VHF radio and all emergency equipment in accordance NMD



## Drivers

All our drivers have the necessary training and certification in accordance NMD requirements for passenger travel.

## Passengers:

All passengers must wear a survival-suit and lifejacket during the entire trip. Slåttebakken Adventure AS possesses the necessary liability insurance for passenger transport which covers the requirements of the NMD.

## Safety instructions to all passengers before departure:

- Always follow the skipper's instructions. This is important if an emergency arises.
- Check survivalsuit and lifejacket, tighten belts and straps to a comfortable level.
- Always sit in assigned seat when the boat is underway.
- Always hold on with at least one hand.
- Provide signal by raising your left hand in the air if you encounter problems during the trip and want to get in touch with the skipper.
- Keep your eyes forward and watch the sea and the conditions around you.
- Have the main strain on the legs, not on the butt.
- Do not bend down in the boat, or against your fellow passengers while traveling.
- Pregnant from 3 months, or people with problems with back, neck, knees or other physical limitations must always notify the skipper of this before departure. Captain can reject people with these limitations, or they must sit at the designated place.
- Visible intoxicated persons will be rejected.
- Passenger is responsible for loss/damage of camera, cell phone, glasses and other personal belongings.
